

We provide a range of educational programs. Serving grades K through 8, we offer after-school tutoring and homework assistance. We also offer a faithbased summer school and a high school intern program to provide opportunities for academic and personal growth.

The pandemic has hurt students in their education and holistic development. As a result, we are seeing a greater need to increase our capacity to service more students. There are nearly 7,000 school-age students from among the local area Bridgeport Public Schools, and it is our prayer to reach more of them. Our current facility is nearly at maximum capacity.
